



PhD and MS Fellowship Program

- local study: receive support for tuition, salary, teacher substitute, and start-up grant up to P2.5M upon completion of PhD (from EIDR program)
- foreign study: receive support for tuition, salary, teacher substitute, RT airfare, living allowance, and start-up grant up to P2.5M upon completion of PhD

Foreign-trained PhD Faculty Recruitment (Balik-PhD) Program

- host unit provides appropriate rank based on recruit’s accomplishments
- outright relocation package of P0.5M and start-up grant up to P2.5M

Visiting Professor Program

- experts from academe, gov’t or industry, local or foreign
- 2-3 weeks, 2-3 months, 6 months-1 year
- team teaching, graduate mentoring, seminars, lectures, research collaboration in host unit
- RT airfare, living allowance augmented by host’s project

Artist-, Scientist-, Academic-in-Residence Program

- world-renowned Filipino or foreign academic
- 6 months to 1 year
- graduate mentoring, keynote lectures, publication or creative output
- RT airfare, full living allowance

Short-term Foreign Postdoctoral Stint or Training Program

- to pursue research project or creative work, to train or update on curriculum and pedagogy, to produce a publication
- 2-4 months stint in foreign university
- RT airfare and living allowance

Externships and Workshops with Industry

- 2-3 months externship in SME or industry
- workshops to explore linkages with industry

HONOR GRADUATE FACULTY FAST TRACK PROGRAM (*summa cum laude* – Instructor 5; *magna cum laude* – Instructor 4; *cum laude* – Instructor 3): close mentoring by senior faculty, access to ECWRG grant (for Instructor 4 & above)

Emerging Inter-Disciplinary Research (EIDR)

The University is inviting innovative, inter-disciplinary, inter-CU research programs and projects that aim to generate new fundamental knowledge which will contribute to the understanding of natural phenomenon, find applications beneficial to human society and nature. Further proof of concept/principle of UP patents for technology transfer and business development are prioritized.

General research areas:

- pervasive, progressive pedagogy
- Philippine culture, arts, mass communication, humanities to enhance national identity, global orientation and tourism
- poverty alleviation: family and community development
- health, disease and wellness
- agriculture, aquaculture, livestock and nutrition
- environment, climate and energy
- biodiversity, conservation and drug discovery
- genomics, other “-omics” and biotechnology
- ICT, engineering, nanotechnology
- computation modeling, complex systems

EIDR grants may be up to P2.5M per project or P10M per program (for 4 projects) per year for 2 years, renewable for another 2 years.

EIDR Start-Up Grant for new local PhD Faculty and REPS

UP faculty and researchers who completed their PhD or long term post-doctoral training after October 2011 may submit a proposal as a single proponent or with another new PhD as co-proponent. The proposal must be directly related to the dissertation and expertise of the proponent(s). Grant is up to P2.5M for a one year project.

Enhanced Creative Work and Research Grant (ECWRG)

The University provides grants for the creative or research work of UP faculty (Instructor 4 to Professor 12) and University Researchers.

Grants vary (based on faculty rank) from P450,000 to P650,000 (less withholding tax) or a 1.5 year project.

Emerging Science and Technology Research Grant (ESTRG)

The University is inviting proposals for inter-/multi-disciplinary research projects/programs focusing on genomics for health, agriculture, biodiversity, forensics.

Balik PhD Start-Up Grant

Foreign trained PhD Faculty Recruits are invited to submit proposals directly related to their dissertations or research projects undertaken abroad for up to P2.5M.

Science Productivity System (SPS)

The UP Scientific Productivity System (SPS) aims to: (1) support the development of science and technology and (2) encourage and reward scientific productivity. Deserving scientists shall be conferred the title “UP Scientist”.

Arts Productivity System (APS)

The UP Arts Productivity System (APS) aims to encourage outstanding productivity in the creative arts or in arts scholarship for national development. Deserving artists and arts scholars in the faculty and research staff shall be conferred the title “UP Artist”.

The title UP Scientist and UP Artist is held for a period of 3 year and comes with a monetary award. The monetary award given per year will be increased to:

Artist I & Scientist I	: P150,000
Artist II & Scientist II	: P200,000
Artist III & Scientist III	: P250,000

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International Publication Award (IPA) for journal articles and books/book chapters

Award (pro-rated) is given to faculty members, researchers, project researchers and thesis students who publish in international peer-reviewed (Thomson Reuters-listed [formerly ISI] or SCOPUS-listed) journal. The amount of the IPA is from P55,000 to P80,000. Authors' home units also receive an IPA.

Award is given to faculty members, REPS, professors emeriti whose books or book chapters are published by international academic book publishers, prestigious university presses and international publishers. The maximum amount of the IPA is P55,000 for a book chapter and P110,000 for a book.

Special Support: Research Dissemination Grant (RDG)

Special support is given to faculty and researchers who will present their papers in prestigious international conferences. The amount of the grant is P25,000 for conferences in Asia and the Pacific Islands; P45,000 for North and South America, Europe, Russia, Africa, Middle East, Australia and India.

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International Scholarships/Fellowships/Grants for Faculty/REPS and Students

University of the Philippines Mobility for Vigor and Excellence (MOVE UP)

For junior or senior undergraduate students with high scholastic average, with full or partial support (based on socialized tuition system) for 1 semester enrollment in a foreign university as exchange student

Continuous Operational and Outcomes–based Partnership for Excellence in Research and Academic Training Enhancement (COOPERATE)

For graduate students at early thesis or dissertation or proposal stage, needing to undertake research/creative work at a foreign university; UP research adviser may undertake a short-term visit to foreign potential research/creative work co-adviser/group; for continuing research/creative work collaboration and publication/productivity

Research/Creative Work Presentation in International Conferences

For faculty, REPS and graduate students support for paper presentation at international conferences; co-funding of Constituent Unit (CU) or other agencies preferred

Hosting of International Conferences, Meetings, Workshops

Hosting of the CUs of international conferences, meetings, and workshops in line with the University's vision and mission

World Experts Lecture Series

Support for air travel, accommodations and per diem for one week, arrangements for the convocation, publicity of the event, social functions for invited eminent world leaders in academe, government and industry to give special lectures in UP
